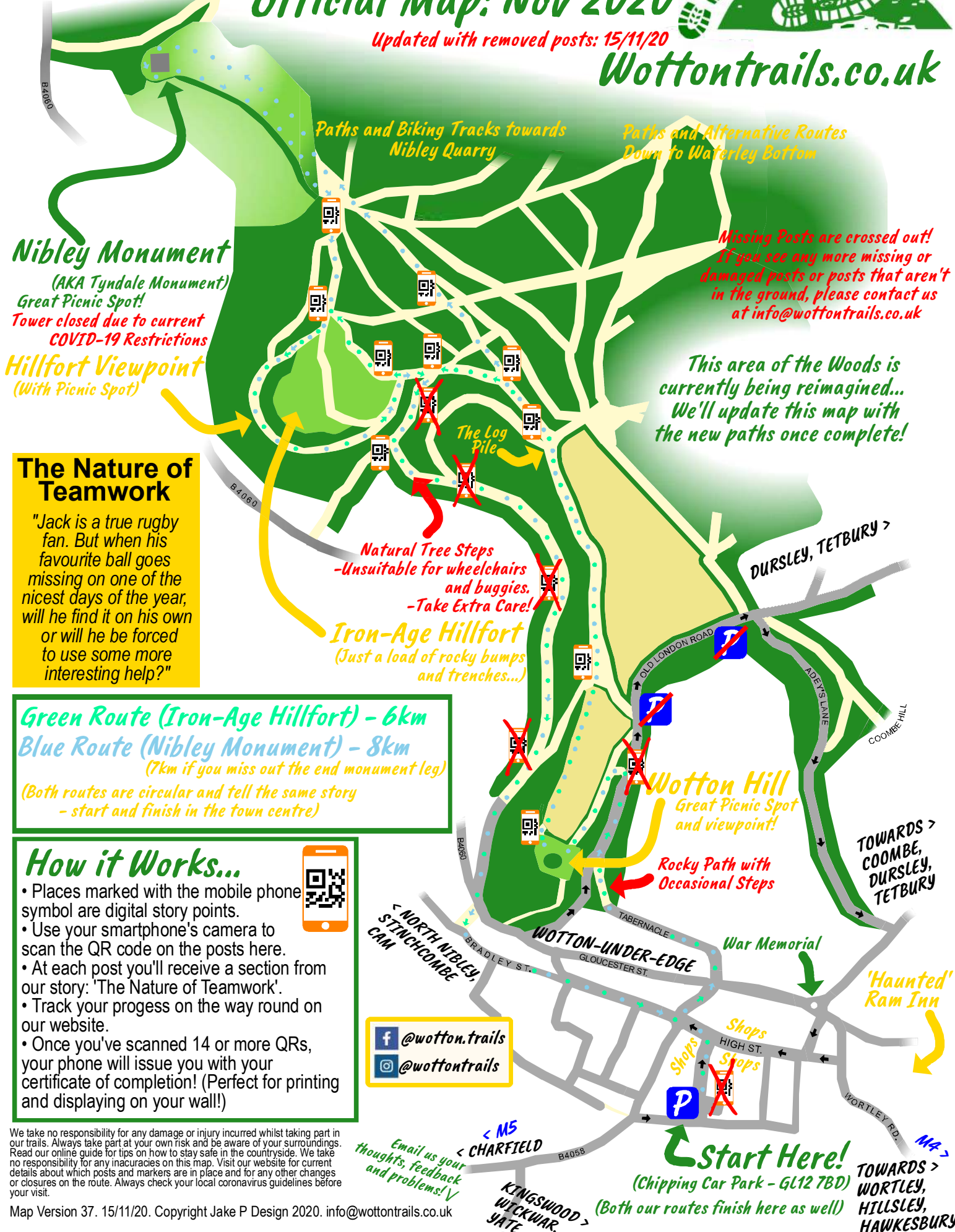

Blue Route (Nibley Monument) - 8km
(7km if you miss out the end monument leg)
(Both routes are circular and tell the same story - start and finish in the town centre)

How it Works...

- Places marked with the mobile phone symbol are digital story points.
- Use your smartphone's camera to scan the QR code on the posts here.
- At each post you'll receive a section from our story: 'The Nature of Teamwork'.
- Track your progress on the way round on our website.
- Once you've scanned 14 or more QRs, your phone will issue you with your certificate of completion! (Perfect for printing and displaying on your wall!)
